

Ballot Paper Template – Constituency of Clare 2020

This message sets out the candidates for the General Election for the Constituency of Clare on the 8th of February 2020 in the order in which they appear on the ballot paper.

If you are a vision impaired voter wishing to vote in secret, ask the Presiding Officer at your polling station to attach a ballot paper template to your ballot paper. Raised numbering and braille on the template guides you to the relevant openings that correspond to the candidates on the ballot paper.

The candidate corresponding to Number 1 on the ballot paper template is **BARRETT – NON PARTY** – David Barrett of Dromelihy, Cree, Kilrush, County Clare, Engineer.

The candidate corresponding to Number 2 on the ballot paper template is **BREEN – FINE GAEL** – Pat Breen of Lisduff, Ballynacally, Ennis, County Clare, Full Time Public Representative.

The candidate corresponding to Number 3 on the ballot paper template is **CAREY – FINE GAEL** – Joe Carey, The Lane, Barntick, Clarecastle, County Clare, Full Time Public Representative.

The candidate corresponding to Number 4 on the ballot paper template **CONWAY – FINE GAEL** – Martin Conway of Woodmount, Ennistymon, County Clare, Full Time Public Representative.

The candidate corresponding to Number 5 on the ballot paper template is – **CROWE – FIANNA FAIL** – Cathal Crowe of Knockroe, Meelick, County Clare, Public Representative.

The candidate corresponding to Number 6 on the ballot paper template is **DOOLEY – FIANNA FAIL** – Timmy Dooley of Tulla, County Clare, Public Representative.

The candidate corresponding to Number 7 on the ballot paper template is – **GARVEY – THE GREEN PARTY** – Roisin Garvey of Inagh, Ennis, County Clare, Travel Education Officer.

The candidate corresponding to Number 10 on the ballot paper template is **McINERNEY – FIANNA FAIL** – Rita McInerney of Mountrivers, Doonbeg, County Clare, Business Owner.

The candidate corresponding to Number 11 on the ballot paper template is **McNAMARA – NON PARTY** – Michael McNamara of Tubbernaagoth, Scariff, County Clare, Farmer & Barrister

The candidate corresponding to Number 12 on the ballot paper template is O'BRIEN – RENUA – Conor O'Brien of 3 Fionora, Lahinch, County Clare, Law Student.

The candidate corresponding to Number 13 on the ballot paper template is O'DONGHOE – SOLIDARITY PEOPLE BEFORE PROFIT – Theresa O'Donohoe, Ardeamush, Lisdoonvarna, County Clare, Mother.

The candidate corresponding to Number 14 on the ballot paper template is WOULFE – NON PARTY – Joseph Woulfe of Emelagh, Quilty, County Clare, Farmer & Barber.

The candidate corresponding to Number 1 on the ballot paper template is WYNNE – SINN FEIN – Violet -Anne Wynne of 4 Pella Road, Kilrush, County Clare, Mother.

Write '1' in the opening on the template that corresponds to the candidate of your first choice; write '2' in the opening that corresponds to the candidate of your second choice, and so on.

You can familiarise yourself with the candidates on the ballot paper by contacting this number as often as you wish in advance of polling day. You can also use your mobile phone in the polling station centre on polling day to access this information.
